## Explanation Letter



The documents seeking an immediate injunction hearing in relation to an injunction against the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) conducting an election on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> September 2013 are re-lodged for the following reasons:

1. The documents reveal serious indictable offences that have been concealed.
2. The Federal Court Rules *do not* stand up against either Statute Law or Common Law, that is rules can be set aside for the attainment of Justice.
3. In relation to the revealed fracture of Federation by the overt act out of Western Australia, the enactment date of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2004 is the date that Federation has been broken. What you are attempting to do is rely upon rules to conceal this discovered fracture.
